DEA National Prescription Take Back Day – FAQs



What can I bring to a DEA Take Back event?

All solid-dosage pharmaceutical products and liquids in consumer containers are accepted. Please make sure caps are tightly sealed to prevent leakage.



Can I bring illicit drugs?

No. Illicit substances (e.g., marijuana, methamphetamine) are not part of this initiative and will not be accepted.



Do you collect information on individuals who drop off medications?

No. This program is anonymous, and all efforts are made to protect your privacy. No questions will be asked and no identification is required.



Will you accept needles or sharps?

No. Intravenous solutions, injectables, and syringes will not be accepted.



Can I drop off liquid medications?

Yes. Keep liquid medications in their original containers with caps tightly sealed to prevent leakage.



Do I need to remove medications from their original containers?

No. You may dispose of medications in the original containers. If you prefer, remove or black out any personal information on the label.

Keep them safe. Clean them out. Take them back.
